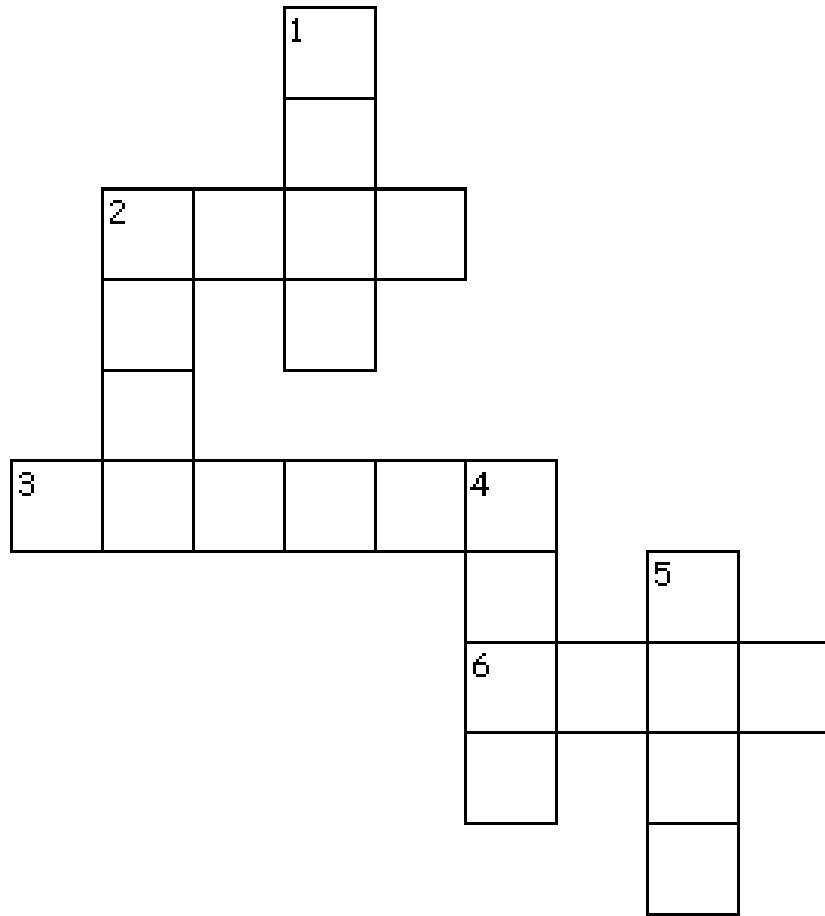

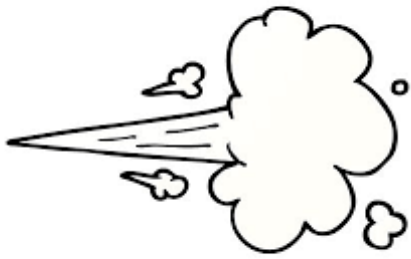

First

Apple Crumble Topping

Ingredients

120g flour

60g sugar

60g cold butter or dairy free spread

Method

Mix the flour and sugar in a bowl.

to mix it with the flour and sugar.

ready!

Apple Crumble Filling

Ingredients

4-6 apples

2 table spoons of strawberry (or any other) jam

3 table spoons of water

Method

Peel and roughly chop your apples.

Add them to a saucepan with the water and simmer until they are soft then stir in your jam.

Tip the mix into an ovenproof bowl and cover with your topping. Bake in the oven at 160 degrees until golden brown.

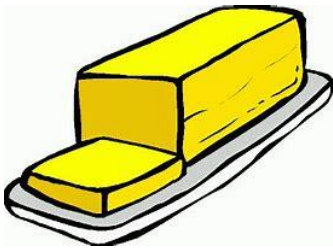

Making Mud Bricks

Things you'll need:

A plant pot/bowl

Ice cube tray (silicone work best)

Dirt from the garden

Water

Sunshine

Fill your pot with dirt and add some water to make mud. Spoon or scoop the mixture into your ice cube tray and press it down with your fingers.

Experiment with a few different mixes (some more wet, some with stones/twigs mixed in).

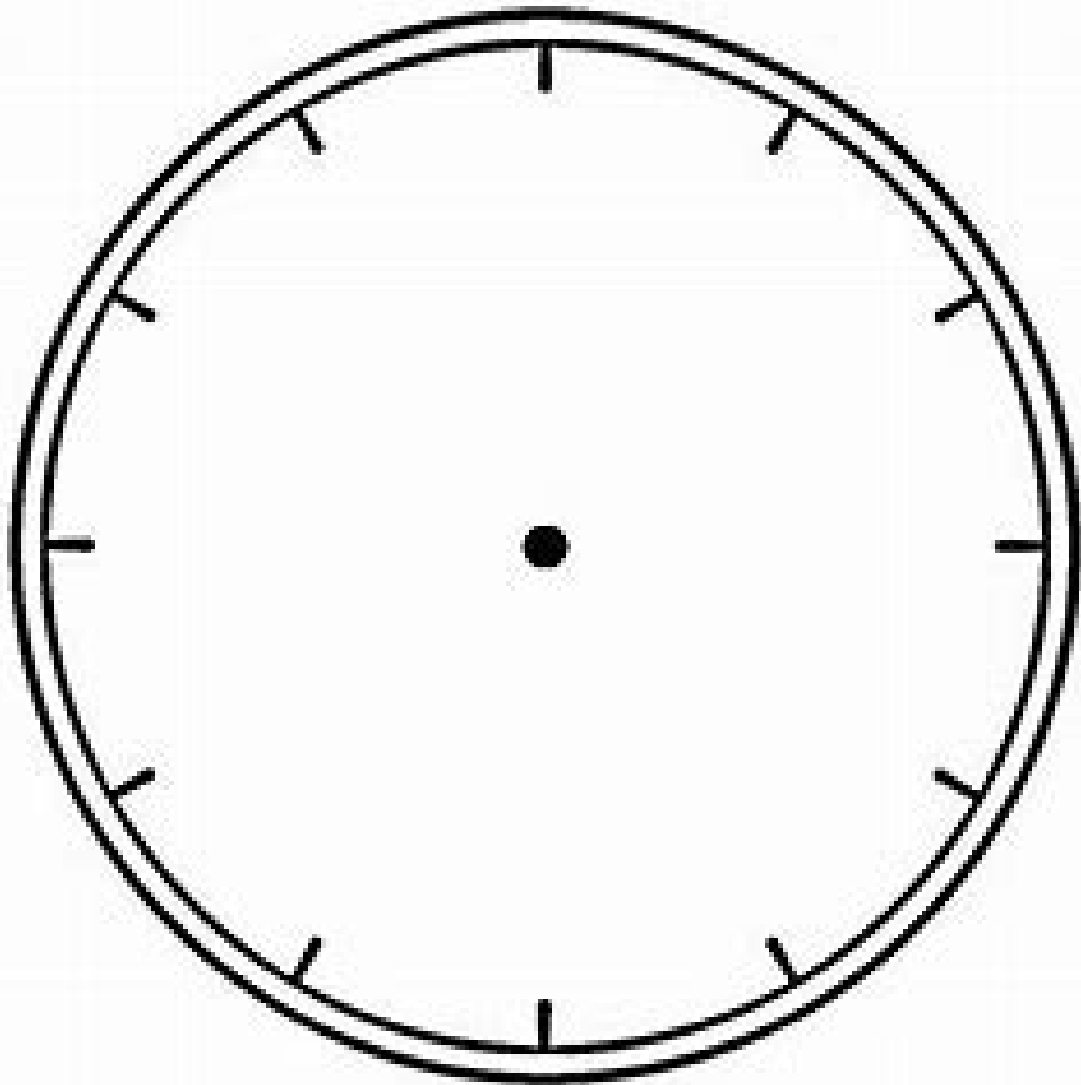
Leave them for a couple of hours to dry and pop them out of the moulds.

Make Your Own Sundial



1. Add the clockface numbers
2. Decorate a paper plate to make a clock base
3. Cut out the clock and stick it to your plate
4. Poke a pencil through the centre hole
5. Line up the pencil shadow when you get to the next o'clock
6. Check your clock every hour to see if your sundial is keeping time!
